## Appeal for Continued Federal Aid Eligibility

One Additional Academic Term Extension

By completing this form, you are acknowledging that you have been on financial aid probation and you are appealing for one final quarter/semester of federal aid eligibility. If an appeal is granted, federal aid will not disburse for periods of enrollment beyond the appeal quarter/semester unless you are meeting the minimum satisfactory academic progress requirements for the receipt of federal aid: minimum course completion rate of 67%, minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 (graduate) or 2.0 (undergraduate), and maximum timeframe to receive federal aid of 150% of published length of program (non-KAM programs) or 32 quarters (KAM programs). The granting of an extension by the Office of Financial Aid is not a guarantee that you will be able to come back into compliance by the end of the appeal term. If you lose federal aid eligibility, you may apply for a private educational loan through a private lender.

Please complete this form and fax it to the Office of Financial Aid as soon as possible. This form is not required to file an appeal. A request may be submitted in the form of a letter as well.
